



ONLINE CPD Programme 2023-24 offered by Fox Federation

Fox Federation's online CPD Programme will consist of individual learning study taken by teachers in their own school or home and teacher-facilitated Zoom sessions. This offer enables teachers to access high-quality CPD while allowing greater flexibility on when and where the modules are taken.

The Fox Federation is a centre of excellence for teacher continued professional development, delivering external training for new and experienced teachers in both the state and independent sectors. It is also a Maths Hub and strategic partner to the local English Hub. Lead teachers, experts in their field, develop and run all courses drawing on their extensive experience of working in a dynamic and outstanding school. Courses include the opportunity to observe exemplary lessons and access resources that will support and enhance teaching. Over 600 teachers received CPD at Fox last year, of which 100% rated their course as 'Very Good' or 'Excellent'. All courses cater for the requirements of the national curriculum and principles can be applied in any setting. Our new online offer means that teachers can continue to access this high-quality provision from the comfort of their own homes or schools. Dates listed below are for the final facilitated session—the two pre-recorded sessions will be released in the week before this date.

These remote sessions will function in the following way

- Each course will have some self-study resources sent out prior to the advertised session. As the facilitated sessions will be in the afternoon, some schools may choose their teachers to do the self-study sections the morning before. The facilitated session will take place on the advertised date of the course.
- There are self-study resources to complete in advance of the facilitated session will cover the majority of subject knowledge and principles discussed in the course. There may also be filmed sessions, which attendees can complete individually during the preceding week of the course, or during the allocated day. These will take between 1 and 1.5 hours to complete each.
- During these sessions, there will be opportunities for teacher reflection. It is important to keep a note of these reflections and questions to submit in advance of the final session.
- The course leader will review key points of learning and provide opportunities for delegates to practise and apply this learning, with feedback and guidance. This session will last 1.5 to 2.5 hours and is hosted on the specified day of the course.

At the end of the facilitated session, there will be an online evaluation to complete, which will then enable more resources to be sent to you.
